Mr. Arnold Lenwood Sutton Jr., 82, of Scooterville, died on Monday, January 31, 2022 at Phoebe Putney Memorial Hospital.

The funeral service will be held at 11:00 AM on Friday, February 4, 2022 at New Hope Baptist Church in Scooterville, Ga. Interment will follow in the Church Cemetery. The Rev. Tim Bozeman will officiate.

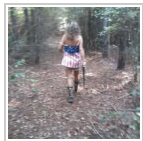
