



Mr. Bennett "Tommy" Pate

January 14, 1950 - June 30, 2021

Mr. Bennett Thomas "Tommy" Pate, 71 of Worth County, passed away peacefully on Wednesday, June 30, 2021 at his home.

The funeral service will be held at 2:00 PM on Saturday, July 3, 2021 at the Northside Baptist Church, interment will follow in the Gordy New Bethel Baptist Church Cemetery. The Rev. Ricky Smarr, and Jimmy Cargle will officiate.

Mr. Pate was born on January 14, 1950 on his family's farm in Crisp County, GA., to the late Perry Parkerson and Betsy Jane Pate. Tommy was best known for his love of singing Southern Gospel Music, for the sole purpose of glorifying his Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. He accepted his Savior in 1974. Tommy sang in the Southern Gospel Quartet for most of his life, going back to the early 1970's. These groups included the Hawpond Messengers, and the Countrymen. He served as the choir Director at Northside Baptist Church. Survivors include his childhood sweetheart and wife of 52 years, Jerri Kay Pate of Worth County; children, Linda "Lynn" Kay Perry (Rusty) of Cordele, Robert Thomas "Bubba" Pate (Heather) of Perry, and Kevin Perry Pate (Leigh Anne) of Sylvester; grandchildren, Thomas Perry, Kaylee Underwood (Chance), Sarah, Madison, Kinsey, Ansley, and Colton Pate; sisters, Shirley Brock, Linda Davison, and Lois Bobo all of Ashburn.

In addition to his parents, Mr. Pate was preceded in death by his granddaughter, Leah Grace Pate
