Mr. Bennie L. Gaskins, 81, of Bridgeboro died Thursday, February 5, 2015 at his residence.

The funeral service will be held at 11:00 AM on Friday, February 13, 2015 at Banks Funeral Home Chapel. Interment will be held at 2:00 PM in the Riverside Baptist Church Cemetery in Nashville. The Rev. Bobby Brown, Rev. Roy Gaskins and Rev. Mark Boyd will officiate.
