



Mrs. Bettye Sue Rivers Eaton

September 24, 1936 - November 1, 2024

Bettye Sue Rivers Eaton, age 88, passed away peacefully on Friday, November 1, 2024, at the home of her sister and brother-in-law, Ronald and Julie Sumner, in Sylvester, Georgia.

The funeral service will be held at 2:00 PM on Tuesday, November 5, 2024, at the First Baptist Church of Sylvester, interment will follow in the Hillcrest Cemetery in Worth County. The Rev. Donnie Duncan will officiate.

She was born September 24, 1936, at home in Sumner, Georgia, to Jake and “Jackie” Mildred Rivers.

A 1954 graduate of Sylvester High School, Bettye Sue went to work in September of that year at the USMC Supply Center in Albany, Georgia. Over a career in federal service spanning 40 years, she served in a variety of managerial and supervisory roles in Albany; Chicago, IL; and Camp Lejeune, NC. She retired as the Director, Life Cycle Management Center, Marine Corps Logistic Base, Albany, GA, October, 1998. A respected leader and beloved mentor, Bettye Sue was the first woman inducted into the Marine Corps Logistics Command Hall of Fame, October, 2008.

Mrs. Eaton was a faithful member of First Baptist Church Sylvester where she was a former Sunday School teacher. She enjoyed reading, cheering on the Rams baseball team, and spending time at the beach. She treasured her family and friends, loving them all “so good.” She will be remembered for her extraordinary generosity, her love for others, and her joyful spirit.

She is survived by her sister and brother-in-law, Ronald and Julie Sumner,

nephew Scott Sumner, a number of cousins, and her beloved Sumner extended family.

Mrs. Eaton was preceded in death by her parents, Jake and “Jackie” Rivers; her husband, Major Max B. Eaton, USMC; and son, John Lawrence Eaton.
