



## Mr. Bobby Leon Bown

Mr. Bobby Leon Brown, 83, of Sumner died Friday, October 16, 2015 at his residence surrounded by his family.

The funeral service will be held at 10:00 AM on Monday, October 19, 2015 at Terrell Baptist Church with interment to follow in the Hillcrest Cemetery. The Rev. Bob Halstead and the Rev. Brad Hughes will officiate.

Mr. Brown was born on December 13, 1931 in Worth County to the late Haywood Lee and Naomi Jutson Lunsford Brown.
