Rev. Charles L. Daniell, 81, of Lee County died Monday, April 3, 2017 at his residence.

The funeral service will be held at 11:00 AM on Thursday, April 6, 2017 at Banks Funeral Home Chapel with interment to follow in the Omega City Cemetery in Omega, GA. Dr. Butch Knight and Rev. Douglas Hatcher will officiate.
