Clarence Ernest "Ace" Adams died Saturday, October 16, 2010 from complications related to Alzheimer's. Mr. Adams was 86. A native of Danielsville, GA, Mr. Adams served in the Army Air Corps as a B-25 pilot during WW II. Following the war, Mr. Adams earned a degree in Industrial Management from Georgia Tech in 1949 where he was a member of the □□□□Fraternity. Upon graduation he began a career in the insurance industry, working for insurance companies in Atlanta, Philadelphia, Cincinnati, eventually achieving the position of VP in charge of underwriting. Mr. Adams became a partner of Lanier Upshaw Insurance Agency of Lakeland, FL in 1967. He received the designation of Chartered Property and Casual Underwriters (CPCU). He retired in 1990. In 2006 he relocated to Gainesville, FL.
