Mrs. Dorothy McLendon Anderson, 92, of Anderson City died Wednesday July 6, 2016 at Pine Shadows Too in Sylvester.

The funeral service will be held at 11:00 AM on Friday July 8, 2016 at Kimball United Methodist Church with interment to follow in the church cemetery. The Rev. AL Lewis will officiate.

Mrs. Anderson was born in Sumter County on July 18, 1923 to the late Herbert Hodges and Frances Wall McLendon. She married James Earle Anderson December 3, 1944 and had lived in Worth County since 1947. Mrs. Anderson received her associate degree in 1942 from Andrew College and her A.B. in 1944 and her Master's in Education in 1955 both from Mercer University. She was a teacher with the Worth County School System from 1947 until her retirement in 1986. Mrs. Anderson was an instructor at Andrew College and taught at Worth Academy. She was a member of the Delta Kappa Gamma Society International since 1956. Mrs. Anderson was also a member of the Worth County Educators' Association; Worth County retired Teachers' Association, Georgia Rural Letter Carriers' Association Auxiliary and the Daughters of the American Revolution, Barnard Trail Chapter and Kimball United Methodist Church.

Survivors include her daughter, Lynne Anderson Rieff (Burt) of Florence, AL; grandchildren, Allison Rieff and Brandon Rieff, sister-in-law, Rose Marie McLendon, and many nieces, nephews and great nieces and nephews. In addition to her parents, Mrs. Anderson was preceded in death by her

husband, James Earle Anderson on December 14, 1982, brothers and sisters-in-law, Harold and Vivian McLendon, Dr. Rembert and Miriam McLendon, Richard McLendon, double first cousins, Elizabeth McLendon and Alton Gray.
