Mr. Everett Oliver Hood, 89, of Sylvester, died on Thursday, December 4, 2025, at Willson Hospice House surrounded by his family.

The funeral service will be held at 3:00 PM on Sunday, December 7, 2025, at Gordy New Bethel Church with the Reverend Bradley Floyd officiating.

Interment with Military Honors will follow in the Hillcrest Cemetery.

Mr. Hood was born on December 29, 1935 in Worth County, to the late Benny Hood and Elise Brown Nelms. He had lived in Worth County all of his life. Mr. Hood was a US Army Veteran who served his country honorably for 12 years with the 101st Airborne at Ft. Campbell in Kentucky and also at the Pentagon. He retired from McGregor Golf as Vice President. Mr. Hood enjoyed golf, woodworking, reading, and working in his yard. He was a faithful member of Gordy New Bethel Church where he loved his church family and served as a Deacon. Mr. Hood was a devoted family man who would do anything for his wife. He accomplished many things in his life but always considered his family to be his greatest achievement.
