Mr. Carroll Franklin "Frankie" Miller, 74 of Worth County, died on Sunday, March 24, 2019 at the Willson Hospice House.

The funeral service will be held at 3:00 PM on Friday, March 29, 2019 at the First Baptist Church of Sylvester, interment will follow in the Hillcrest Cemetery. The Rev. Donnie Duncan will officiate.
