Mr. Gaylord N. Bice, 84, of Sylvester died Tuesday April 22, 2014 at his residence.

The funeral service will be held at 10:00 AM on Saturday April 26, 2014 at Unity Baptist Church. The Rev. Tim Bice and Rev. Matt Green will officiate.
