Mr. Jack Whiddon, 86, of Worth County, died on Sunday, May 26, 2024.

The funeral service will be held at 11:00 AM on Wednesday, May 29, 2024, at Banks Funeral Home Chapel, interment will follow in the Red Oak Baptist Church Cemetery in Worth County. The Rev. Glenn Whiddon will officiate.

Mr. Whiddon was born on April 16, 1938 in Worth County, to the late E.J. and Lesteree Wishum Whiddon. He had lived in Worth County all of his life, and was a veteran having served in the United States Air Force from 1957 until 1960.
