Mr. James A. "Jim" King, 87, of Sylvester died Monday, February 16, 2015 at his residence.

The funeral service will be held at 11:00 AM on Wednesday, February 18, 2015 at the Evergreen Baptist Church with interment to follow in the Evergreen Cemetery. The Rev. Todd Brooks, the Rev. Ronald Barrett and Mr. Arthur Smith will officiate.

Mr. King was born in Ware County on September 21, 1927 to the late James Harvey and Annie May Beverly King. He had lived in Worth County since 1956. Mr. King was a U. S. He retired from Southern Bell/AT&T after 31 years and was a member of the Telephone Pioneers of America. He spent his years in retirement being a devoted Christian, father, grandfather, fisherman, hunter, farmer and most of all a devoted husband. He had a generous heart that his family, friends and neighbors knew. He entered the kingdom of God surrounded by family and faith. Mr. King was a member of Evergreen Baptist Church and the Men's Sunday School Class.
