Mr. John E. Jones, Jr., 85, of Sumner, died Saturday, April 2, 2016 at Tift Regional Medical Center.

The funeral service will be held at 3:00 PM on Tuesday, April 5, 2016 at Pine Forest Baptist Church with interment to follow in the Hillcrest Cemetery. The Rev. Jason Jones will officiate.
