Mr. Joseph David Brooks, Sr., 84, of Tifton, died Friday, April 14, 2017, at home after a short illness. He was surrounded by his family at the time of his passing. The funeral service will be at 11 AM on Monday, April, 17, 2017, at Evergreen Baptist Church with interment to follow in the Evergreen Cemetery.
