



Dr. Juneseok Park

May 2, 1942 - March 20, 2022

Juneseok Park, 79, passed away unexpectedly on March 20, 2022.

Dr. Park was born in Korea. He was a graduate of Seoul National University College of Medicine and subsequently served as an officer and a medical doctor in the South Korean army.

In 1969, Dr. Park came to the U.S. for his internship in Ohio and residency in Massachusetts. He practiced in Pennsylvania before deciding the winters were simply too cold.

In 1978, Dr. Park moved his family to Sylvester, Georgia where he became the city's first general surgeon. One of the reasons he gave for choosing Sylvester was, "I was looking for a place where I could give more service to more people. I hope I can be of help to the town." The hot and sunny weather agreed with him, and he stayed. For the next 30 years, he diligently provided care for the members of the community and became known for his patience and intellect. Dr. Park was a humble and principled man who unequivocally believed in living his life with integrity. As a member of the community posted, "Dr. Park was an institution in Sylvester and he made it a better place to live."

What brought Dr. Park true joy was his family. He could often be found on the tennis courts with his children, helping them improve their strokes, after a day

at the office or in the operating room. Years later, he was pleased to offer the same tennis dedication to his grandchildren, who also benefited from grandpa's newfound interest in baking. His homemade brioche bread was legendary, with 2 full sticks of butter in each loaf! During the pandemic, grandpa particularly enjoyed his regular video calls with his grandchildren; they were the highlight of his day.

He is survived by his devoted wife, Youngkil and their children, James and Mary as well as his beloved grandchildren Emmeline, Spencer, Mason, and Celso.

A memorial service was held on April 16, 2022 in honor of Dr. Park.

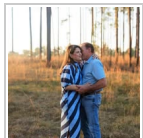
