Mr. Marvin W. Jackson, 93 of Poulan, died on Tuesday, January 19, 2021 at his residence.

Mr. Jackson was born on February 7, 1927 in Marion, S.C., to the late Waymond David and Lula Lorene Turner Jackson. He began his military career in the United States Navy and later retired after 27 years of service as a MSGT in the United States Army having served in WWII, the Korean War and the Vietnam War where he earned the Purple Heart and Bronze Star with Valor.
