I mean, I am, but ya can.” He told me he was serious about taking care of myself and to look after my daddy and my mama. It was days before the accident. I was planning on stopping by THAT Saturday...and then I heard. 😞

I’m sure people are different around different people, but I never saw a different version of Mr. Michael no matter who was there! 100% authentic, fair, honest, and caring! I miss my phone calls!

I’m just so heartbroken, and there is not a doubt in my mind that he’s with God or hanging out at the rainbow bridge checking out all the animals he gave final dignity to...but in their glorious conditions once more. 💕
