Mr. Milton Sledge, 77 of Ty Ty, passed away on Thursday, March 18, 2021 at Legacy Village in Tifton with Elaine, his wife of 56 years, sitting by his side. The funeral service will be held at 2:00 PM on Sunday, March 21, 2021 at the First Baptist Church of Ty Ty, interment will follow in the Church Cemetery. The Rev. Rodney Owens will officiate.

Mr. Sledge was born on July 30, 1943 in Tift County, GA., to the late James and Elizabeth Chapman Sledge. He had lived in Worth County all of his life. Mr. Sledge loved being a farmer. 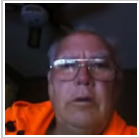
