Mr. John A. Halstead, 90, of Sylvester died Wednesday December 29, 2010 at Magnolia Manor Nursing Home in Americus.

The funeral service will be held Saturday, January 1, 2011 at 2:00 PM at Banks Funeral Home Chapel with interment to follow in the Hillcrest Cemetery. Rev. Stan Halstead and Rev. Brian Allen officiating.
