Mr. Raymond D. Spindler, 88, of Albany died Tuesday, March 28, 2017 at Phoebe Putney Memorial Hospital.

The funeral service will be held at 11:00 AM on Friday, March 31, 2017 at Amazing Grace Baptist Church in Albany with interment to follow in the New Hope Church Cemetery. Rev. Davis Thurman and Dr. Morris Harp will officiate.

Mr. Spindler was born on March 20, 1929 in Olustee, FL to the late William N. and Ruth Rebecca Stewart Spindler, Jr. He had lived in Albany since 1956. Mr. Spindler was Veteran having served in the United States Marine Corps during the Korean War. He continued to serve in the Army Reserves until his retirement. Mr. Spindler worked at the Marine Corps Logistics Base for 37 ½ years as an Occupational Safety and Health Specialist before retiring. He enjoyed running and completed 14 marathons. Mr. Spindler was a member of Triangle Lodge #708 F & AM having been a past Worshipful Master. He attended Amazing Grace Baptist Church where he was former member of the Board of Trustees and also served in many other capacities.

Survivors include his wife of 13 years, Katherin "Katie" Spindler of Albany; grandson Todd Spindler of Claxton, GA; 2 great-granddaughters and 1 great-grandson.

In addition to his parents, Mr. Spindler was preceded in death by his first wife, Dorothy H. Spindler on November 19, 2003 and two sons, David L. Spindler and Nick Spindler.
