Mr. Reid Mullis, 84 of Sylvester, died on Tuesday, April 20, 2021 at his residence.

Mr. Mullis was born on November 06, 1936 in Vienna GA to the late Rayford Wallace Mullis, Sr. and Evelyn Reid Mullis.
