



Mr. Robert Lamar Weaver, Sr.

Robert (Lamar) Weaver 71, of Sylvester died Monday, October 17, 2011 at Phoebe Putney Memorial Hospital. His family will be receiving friends at Banks Funeral Home Thursday, October 20, 2011, from 6:00 PM until 8:00 PM. Funeral services will be held at Poulan Baptist Church at 3:00 PM, where Mr. Weaver was a member, on Friday, October 21, 2011 with the Rev. Michael DeLoach officiating. Mr. Weaver was born on April 29, 1940 in Toccoa, Georgia and moved to Sylvester, Georgia in the early sixties. He became employed at Coat's and Clark's where he worked for fifteen years during which time he was promoted to the position shift supervisor, as well as logging part time with his father, J.R. Weaver. Mr. Weaver owned the Weaver Timber Company and has been logging full time for the last 45 years. He was also a member of the Poulan Chapter of Lion's Club.

Survivors are his wife of 49 years, Peggy Jones Weaver, a native of North Carolina, two daughters, Sheila Patterson (George), Lori Potts (Steve), one son, Robert L. Weaver, Jr. (Stacy), two
