Mr. Thomas Walter Lawhorne, Sr., 87, passed away November 27, 2011 at Kindred Hospital in Tulsa, Oklahoma.

Mr. Lawhorne was born October 24, 1924 in Worth County, Georgia to the late Onie Shepard and Alice Saunders Lawhorne where he has lived most of his life.
