



## Mr. Wiley Jones

July 16, 1921 - July 27, 2016

Mr. Wiley A. Jones, 95, of Lafayette, passed away on Wenesday July 27, 2016 at The Springs of Lafayette.

The funeral service will be held at 3:00 PM on Saturday July 30, 2016 at Trinity United Methodist Church. Pastor Tracey Leslie will officiate. Interment will follow on Saturday August 6, 2016 at 1:00 PM in the Poulan Cemetery.

Mr. Jones was born on July 16, 1921 in Brooks County to the late Daniel and Mattilu White Jones. He earned his Bachelor's degree from the University of Georgia and his law degree from Atlanta Law School. Mr. Jones was a United States Marine Corps Veteran of WWII having served in the South Pacific. His first marriage was to Margaret McPhaul who preceded him in death on January 8, 1972. Mr. Jones later married Anabel Ratcliff on October 4, 1975. He was Vice President of Marketing with National Homes from 1967 until 1979. Later he started a home building business in Lafayette. Mr. Jones was a member of Trinity United Methodist Church; he loved spending time with family and friends, attending Purdue Football and Basketball games.
