Mr. William "Willie" Culpepper, 91 of Worth County died Tuesday December 2, 2025 at his residence.

The funeral service will be held at 11:00 AM on Friday, December 5, 2025, at Banks Funeral Home with Minister Eddie Garcia and Reverend Dan Harper officiating. Interment will follow in the Poulan City Cemetery.

He retired from Harvey's Supermarket after spending 45 years helping customers from all over the area. Mr. Culpepper enjoyed gardening, working with his daylillies and cows, and spending time with his grandchildren. He was known by everyone who worked for him as "Mr. C", although to his grandchildren and close friends, he was always "Pa". Mr. Culpepper was attended Poulan Methodist Church. He will be deeply missed by his family and friends. 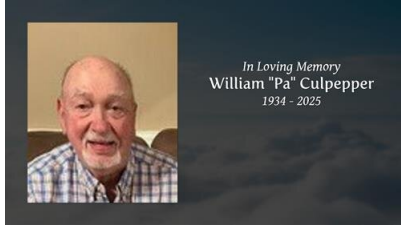
